

• Event Response Strategy :

- Put in place a "real time" event communication strategy
- Implement an integrated WANO emergency response plan in coordination with the IAEA



Credibility :

- Conduct a corporate peer review of every member utility within the next six years
- Improve the quality of existing peer reviews
- Increase the frequency of WANO peer reviews to once every four years
- Establish a WANO assessment, or "grade", following each peer review

Visibility :

✓ Improve WANO visibility and transparency

Internal Consistency :

 Conduct assessments of each WANO Region and London
